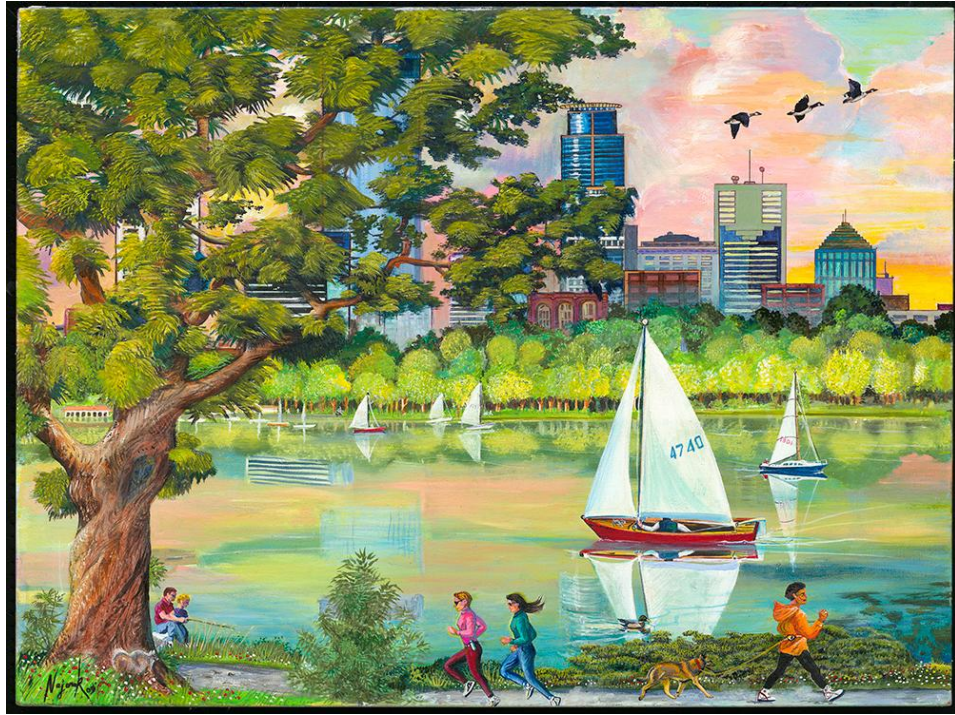


## About “Taste of the City”: the Artist’s Vision
